(No commercial business waste will be accepted e.g., painting contractors.)

What do I bring?

Unwanted household hazardous products. Preferably items kept in original containers. Residents are limited to a maximum of 25 gallons of paints/stains.

LATEX PAINT IS *NOT* HAZARDOUS. Bring to transfer station.

EXAMPLES OF ITEMS YOU CAN BRING

EXAMPLES OF WHAT **NOT** TO BRING

Latex Paint	PCB's	Asbestos
Ammunition, Fireworks	Explosives	Radioactive/Gas Cylinders
Infectious/Biological Wastes	Prescription Medicines/Syringes	Smoke Detectors
Commercial or Industrial Waste	Tires/Empty Aerosols`	Compressed Gas Cylinders

How can I safely transport hazardous materials?

Tighten caps and lids leaving materials in original labeled containers. Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper. Sort and pack separately; oil paint, pesticides, household cleaners.

Never Mix Chemicals! Never smoke while handling hazardous material.

Mercury and Battery Collection

Bring thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent and compact bulbs, batteries: Rechargeable, Button cell, Ni-Cad, Ni-Zn, Ni-Mh, Li-ion, Lead-Acid, Cell Phones (Alkaline e.g., AA, C, etc. batteries may be thrown into your household trash)
